University Entrance Requirements and Subject Selection Guidelines

- To qualify for university entrance, students must have a First Language at AS level and at least a Second Language at IGCSE level. All IGCSE examinations are written at the end of Year 10.
- To take any science subject, students must have a minimum aggregate of 60% in Year 8 Combined Sciences. A maximum of two science subjects may be selected. Admission is subject to management review, based on the overall academic performance of Year 8.
- The Sciences and Mathematics are offered at both Core and Extended levels; however, students must write the IGCSE exam at the Extended level to continue with these subjects at AS Level. All students begin IGCSE on the Extended level.
- Progression to AS level requires a minimum recommended IGCSE aggregate of a "C" in all subjects.
- For the AS level, students must choose three of their six IGCSE subjects (excluding English, which is compulsory).
- It is the responsibility of students and parents to verify university and course-specific entry requirements.
